NCGA TOURNAMENT QUALIFYING GUIDELINES

The following guidelines will be in effect for all NCGA Tournament Qualifying events held by the Sacramento Golf Club.

- 1. The SGC qualifying events will be run as a tournament within a tournament-there will be two events and therefore two results- being competed for at the same time. For example, if a 2 person Best Ball event is being played along with an NCGA 2 Person Best Ball Qualifying event, players will have the option to participate in either the SGC portion of the event, the NCGA Qualifying portion of the event, or both.**
- 2. The regular \$10 entry fee will be collected for each part the players elect to play in (\$20 if they chose to play in both parts).**
- 3. NCGA events may limit the handicap that players can use in their events. Most NCGA events have an 18.4 maximum index and play is at 90% of the course handicap (95% for women). If a player has an index of over 18.4, they may still participate but they must play at an 18.4 index. The SGC will use the same guidelines in our qualifying events and the corresponding NCGA event in the future.**
- 4. SGC members attempting to qualify for NCGA events must have played in 3 club events in the previous 12 months. This was an SGC policy in the past, and many other clubs have the same policy. (Special circumstances, such as injury or illness that has limited a players ability to play, will be reviewed by the President of the Sacramento Golf Club for possible exemption.)**
