## **TIE BREAKING GUIDELINES**

**If there are ties in Sacramento Golf Club events, the following procedures will be used:**

**The players who are tied will have their scores on the last nine holes (holes 10-18) compared. If the tie is not broken, the scores for the last six holes (holes 13-18) will be compared. If the tie is still not broken, the last three holes (holes 16-18) will be compared. If the tie is still not broken, the scores on the last hole (18) will be compared. If the tie still is not broken, then we will do the same thing using the front nine holes-compare the first 9 hole scores; the last six holes of the front nine; the last 3 holes of the front 9; and then the last hole on the front nine.**

**In Net events, handicap strokes will be used on the hole they apply to on the golf course. For example, an 11 handicap male player playing the MacKenzie Course would receive strokes on holes 10, 11, 13, 15, and 17. Strokes on those holes would be applied in the Tie Breaking procedure. If a man and woman are partners, handicap strokes will be applied on the appropriate tees played-Men on the Men's handicap holes and Women on the Women's handicap holes. If the event is a team event and there is only a team handicap (such as a Scramble), the handicap strokes will be applied from the Men's handicap holes.**
