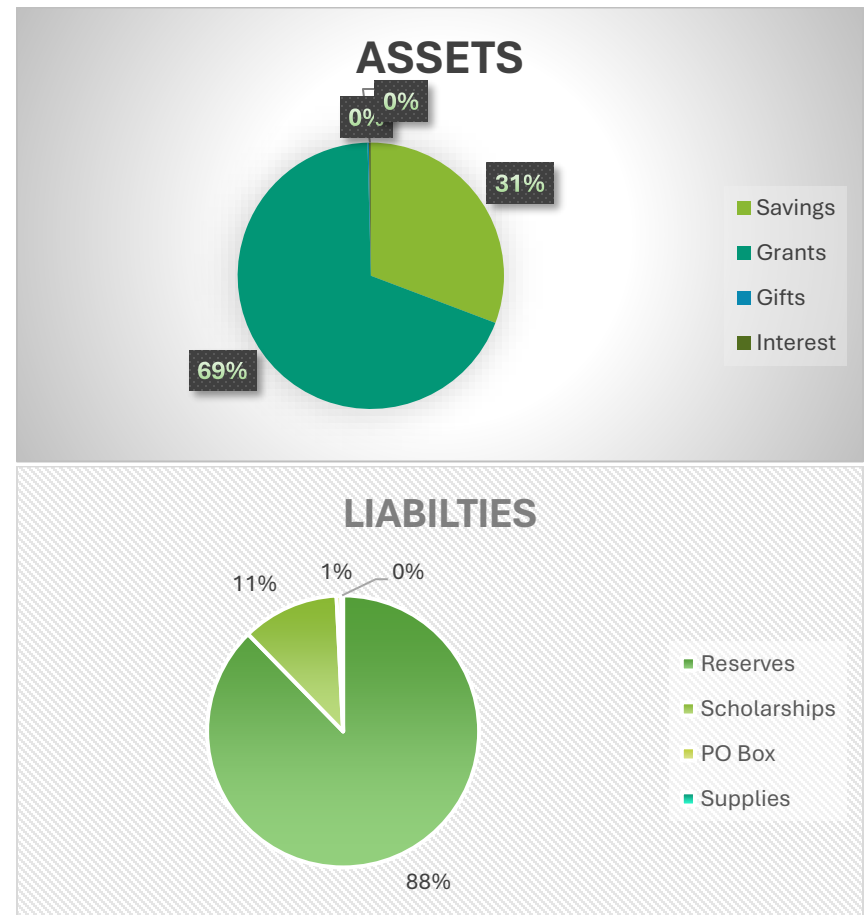
BACKGROUND

The Foundation is established as a Washington State 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation in 2003 led by PSC CSI Past President Robert Simmons. Prior to that time, the Puget Sound Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute had only a Memorial Trust Fund to memorialize those past members of the chapter who had died and served well.

SCHOLARSHIPS
