

2020 NCGA ASSOCIATE CLUB TOURNAMENT OPPORTUNITIES

As an Associate Club within the NCGA, it allows the **UC Golf Club (UCGC)** to send individuals and teams to NCGA Associate Club Tournaments listed below. UCGC holds qualifying events throughout the year for these events. One of the perks of belonging to UCGC is that qualifying teams & individuals are subsidized by UCGC (the club pays 75% of the entry fees).

*Due to the entry deadline, UCGC holds the qualifier for these events in the prior year during the annual Two Person Better Ball Championship.

- 1. Player Commitment: All players that qualify and agree to represent UCGC at the NCGA events are expected to fulfill their commitment and participate as required. Failure to fulfill this commitment can lead to forfeiture of participation in future years events. Also, qualifying players will be responsible for a \$35 fee per NCGA tournament. This covers all rounds in the event. UCGC will subsidize the remaining fee amount (\$100).***
- 2. Participation Limits: To afford maximum opportunities for all members, each person can only qualify for one NCGA event each year. So if you qualify for one of the early events, please be cognizant of your playing partners which may impact their ability to qualify for future events.***
- 3. Team Event Indexes: Per NCGA criteria, all rounds (including UCGC Qualifying) play at 90% (men) and 95% (women) of their course handicap using a maximum handicap index of 18.4. All players with handicap indexes of 18.5 and above are eligible but must play to a maximum index of 18.4.***
- 4. Qualifying: For UCGC events, ties are broken by the scorecard matching system. THERE ARE NO EXTRA HOLES PLAYED. For NCGA qualifiers, approximately 20 to 30% of the teams/individuals will move on to the Championship proper. Ties are also broken through scorecard matching.***
- 5. Substitutions: Please note that the advancing teams or individuals cannot substitute a player after the Qualifying Round. If prior to the Qualifying Round, one or both players of a twosome has a conflict and can't play, the twosome is deemed ineligible and the next UC Qualifying team in line will take their place for the event. **IF YOU QUALIFY, MAKE SURE YOU CAN PLAY ON ALL OF THE DATES BEFORE COMMITTING.*****
