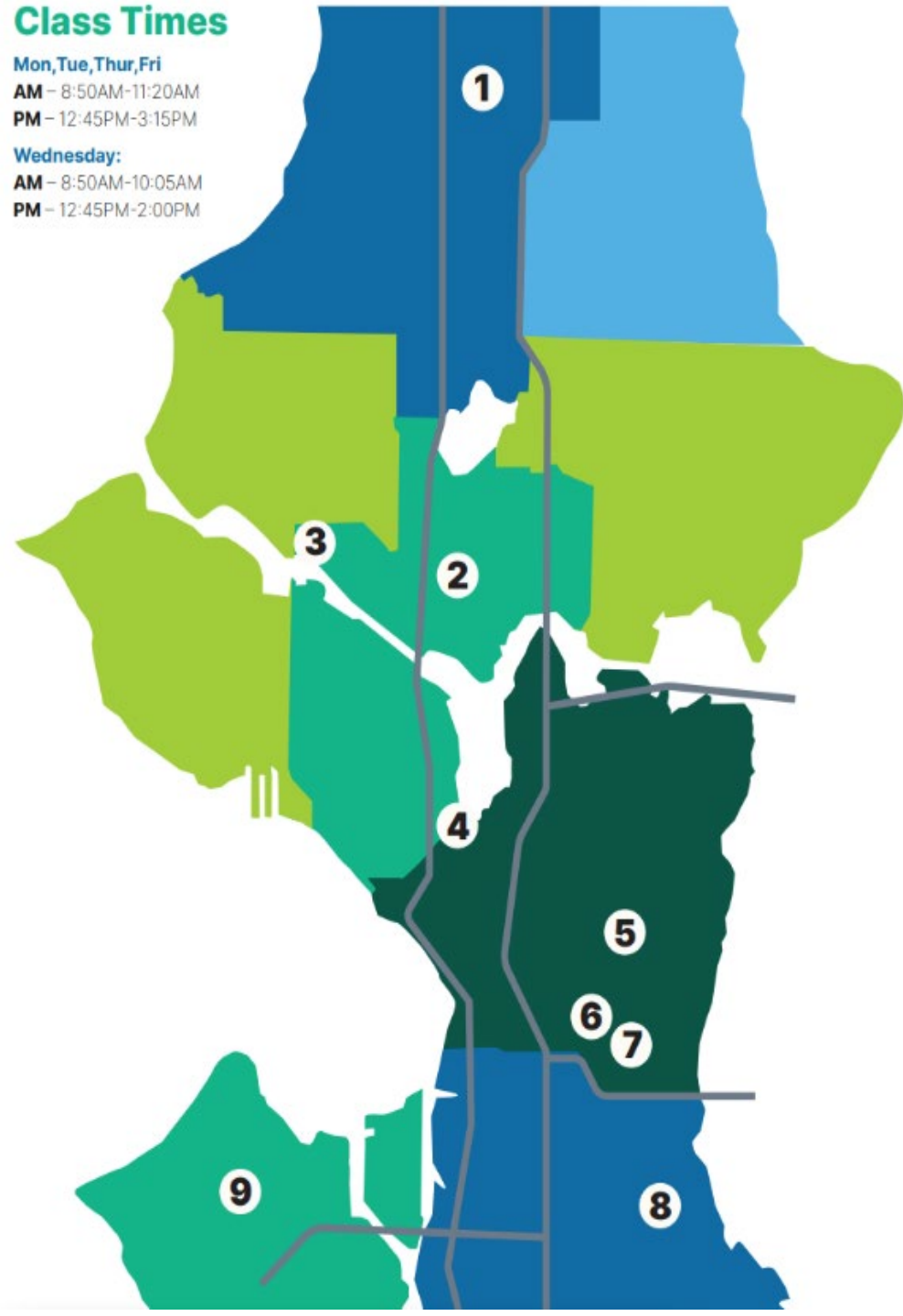

Seattle Skills Center Intro

- Seattle Skills Center offers unique and rigorous training opportunities to students in Seattle Public Schools
- Skills Center classes take place all at schools all over the district and at community-based organizations
 - 9 Locations during the school year, 12-13 locations during the summer (open to 8th graders)
- Students can attend Skills Center classes at any of these locations
- During the school year, transportation may be available for students who request and qualify for home school to Skills Center transportation

Skills Center Intro

- Students who graduate from Skills Centers...
 - Go to College
 - Pursue further training or apprenticeships
 - Enter the workforce into family-wage jobs
 - Have a good strong sense of the kind of work that they want to pursue after high school
 - Leave SPS with 21st Century skill sets required for our changing economy



Skills Center School Year Intro

- Skills Center classes are a year-long
 - Students earn 1.5 CTE Credits per semester (credit equivalencies, cross-credits, and college credit are available)
- Skills Center classes are a half-day long (3 periods out of a standard 6-period day)
 - AM Classes: 8:50-11:20PM (dismissal at 10:05AM on Wednesdays)
 - PM Classes: 12:45-3:15PM (dismissal at 2PM on Wednesdays)



School Year Programs

- During the School Year, we offer programs in...
 - Construction
 - Health Sciences/Medical Assisting
 - Maritime Vessel Operations
 - Media Arts
 - Video Game Animation and Programming
 - Advanced Manufacturing in Aerospace and Maritime
 - Automotive Technology
 - Firefighting and Emergency Medical Services
 - Teaching Academy
 - Nursing Assistant Programs

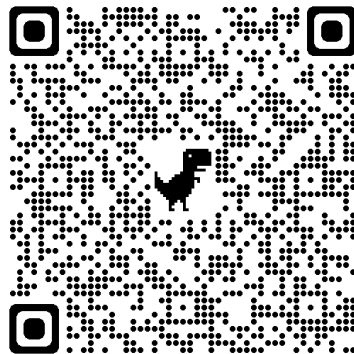






Enrollment – School Year

- Step 1 - Apply for classes in March/April
 - Check our website and social media accounts for announcement of open application
- Step 2 - Skills Center confirms schedule with counselor
 - Confirmation of enrollment once counselor approves
- Step 3 - Start classes in September!



Summer Programs – Earn 0.5 CTE Credits

Offerings change each summer based on student interest and teacher availability. In the past, we have offered introductory classes in:

- Internship Programs for Credit

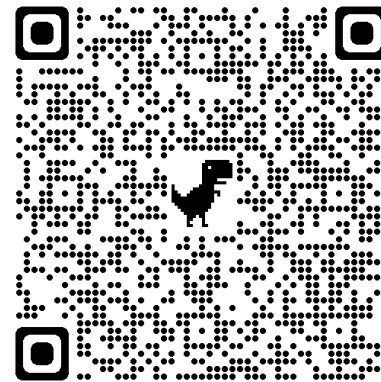
Enrollment – Summer

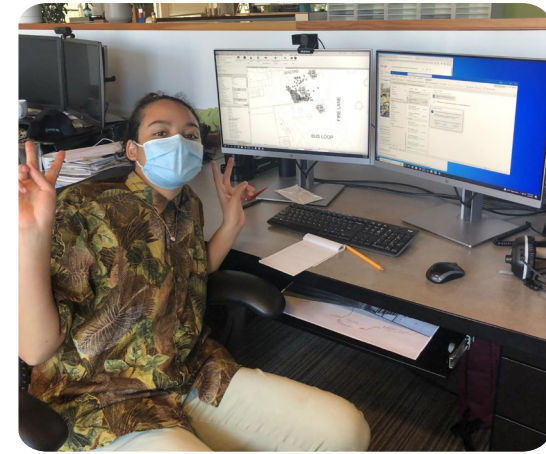
